## THE EASTER SEPULCHRE

The Easter Sepulchre is behind the panelling on the east wall. It was used in medieval times during the Good Friday ritual, when the sacred elements were housed here from Good Friday until Easter Morning, and to make sure the elements were not stolen for use in witchcraft, a member of the church watched over them. The person was sometimes paid in 'brayd' and 'drynke', for 'wochyng of ye sepulkr'.
