The Hotel was built in 1905 at Minnis Bay. It stood on the eastern headland of the Bay for 56 years like a sentinel. When it was closed and demolished in about 1961, the residents of the Bay, and many of the villagers were horrified to see three large blocks of soulless flats erected on the site.
