Hezekiah and Elizabeth were married on the 15th. October 1812 in Birchington, witnesses to the marriage were William Chapman and Elizabeth Howther they

were married by banns. She was the daughter of William Chapman and Sarah nee Burton

Hezekiah was born August 1787 and christened 02/09/1787, in Birchington, he died on the 30th. November 1876 aged 89 he is buried in All Saints Birchington. Elizabeth died on the 17th. November 1868 aged 80, also buried in All Saints.

1841 census Hezekiah and Elizabeth are living at Westgate Farm, they have with them Ellanor 20, George 10 and Elizabeth 8 as yet unable to confirm that the two girls are their daughters.

1851 Hezekiah and Elizabeth were living Westgate Hezekiah is said to be an ag. Labourer he is 73 Elizabeth is stated at wife aged 72 and born in Acol. Also there is William Bartlett age 3 and a grandson.

1861 Hezekiah and Elizabeth were living in Acol with their daughter Jane aged 33, he is an ag. lab. She is shown as an ag. labourers wife. Jane has no profession and is a spinster.

1871 He is living with his daughter Jane she is still unmarried, in this census their name is mis-spelt (Goodburn). They are living at East End (no village mentioned) Jane is her father's housekeeper and Hezekiah a retired ag. labourer.

SARAH SIDDERS born 1814 was interred in All Saints Birchington, 17/06/1832 aged 18 she died in Westgate.

WILLIAM GOODBOURN (1815) AND ELIZABETH MILLGATE (1st. wife) (son of Hezekiah)

William and Elizabeth married in 1835, Elizabeth died in the April of 1836 aged 27, and is buried in All Saints churchyard Birchington Kent. At the time of their marriage she was a spinster, of the parish of Birchington, and he was a bachelor from Acol. The witnesses to the marriage were Hannah Goodbourn and Robert Bushell, they were married by banns.

WILLIAM GOODBOURN (1815) AND MARY ANN HAWKINS (2nd. Wife)

Lawrence Harlow and Caroline Hawkins. Married by Banns, they were married on the 04/08/1838 in the Parish Church of Birchington in the county of Kent.

1841 They were living in Acol Street Acol Kent with Sarah and George. William and ag. Labourer.

1851 They are living in ???? Street, Birchington, with Daniel, George, Sarah, William and John. William is still an Ag. Labourer.

IN BOTH THE ABOVE CENSUS THE SURNAME HAD BEEN TRANSCRIBED AS GOODBURN.

1861 censes William and Mary Ann were living in Cottage Street with their son John, no other children are there, both William and John are ag. labourers.

1871 The three of them are living in a private house, John is still single.

1881 William and Mary are living in Park House Carter Lane Birchington, Kent, William is still an ag. labourer aged 65, Mary is 66.

1891 William and Mary are living at Margate Road, Birchington Kent. William has no occupation.

1901 Mary aged 87 and now a widow is living with her daughter Ann at 34, Church Street, Margate, where Ann is a domestic servant and single aged 44. (unconfirmed yet as Williams widow).

William George Goodbourn died and was interred 22/06/1894 aged 79 in All Saints Birchington Kent. There are two deaths found for a Mary Ann 1-died in March 1906 aged 93, death registered in Thanet 2-died and interred in All Saints 27/10/1893 cannot confirm which one is correct.

SARAH GOODBOURN 1839 not find any details regarding her but there is a record of Sarah Goodbourn dying in 1846 aged 7.

GEORGE GOODBOURN 1841 AND MARTHA BRETT

Martha was the daughter of Thomas Brett Jun. and Sarah Young. She was christened 26/05/1839 in St. Mary Magdalene Monkton. They married in the July/September quarter of 1860 in Thanet.

1871 Living 17, Sussex Place Ramsgate with the four surviving children, also living there were Charles and Albert Colyer age 22 and 24, they were bricklayer labourers.

1881 they are living at 104, Kings Street, Ramsgate. George born 1841 was a master bricklayer employing one man and one boy, the boy being his son George aged 16, Edward 14, was an errand boy, and so was Arthur 12, Sarah was at

school, Martha (wife) was a Chandler's shop keeper, they had one servant, Ann Goldfinch aged 21.

1891 George and Martha were living at 2, Camden Square, Ramsgate with George 28 Edward 24 and Sarah 22

1901 George is now married to Ellen they are living 1, Trinity Terrace Ramsgate Kent.

1911 George and Ellen are living in Birchington House Southwood Road Ramsgate.

Martha died in 1892 aged 53, after her death George married Ellen Gibbens in 1893, he died in November 1916 and is buried with Martha, Ellen died in December 1916, but is buried with Stephen Gibbens in a grave just beyond theirs. Stephen and Ellen called themselves man and wife although they never married.

HARRIETT cannot find any trace of her, either in church or BMD records therefore discounting her as a child of William and Mary Ann as present.

DANIEL GOODBOURN AND CAROLINE NEE BURCHELL

CHILDREN OF THE ABOVE. May born 1878 Gertrude born 1880 Reginald Born 1881 Helen born 1884.

Daniel born 1843 married Caroline Burchell from East Kingston Oxfordshire in the June/September quarter of 1876 at St George's Hanover Square.

1851 Daniel was living with his parents.

1871 Daniel had moved to London where he was a manservant in the Household of Sarah Godman in St. George, Hanover Square, also there as a servant is Caroline.

1874 Daniel and Caroline marry.

1881 Living at 13, Vincent Square, St. John the Evangelist, Westminster, London with their family. Daniel is a lodging house keeper.

1891 Still all details as above, but now living at 25, Vincent Square.

1901 Daniel is a widower Caroline having died in the April June quarter of 1894, aged 47. All family and birth dates are as above but Daniel is transcribed as being born in Hampshire. His daughter May aged 23 and unmarried was his housekeeper, Gertrude aged 21 is a certified school mistress, Reginald is a bookseller, and Helen aged 17, is a pupil teacher in an elementary school.

Daniel died in 1928 aged 84 at St George Hanover Square London.

WILLIAM 1844 AND FRANCIS NEE CLARK

Both William and Frances births were registered at the Isle of Thanet, register office, in the sub district of Minster in Thanet. Both fathers are shown to be labourers. Both births were registered by their mother Harriett Clark made her mark, as she was unable to write. William and Frances were married at the Wesleyan Chapel, Hawley, Margate in the district of Thanet, on the 12/12/1869, witnesses to the marriage we Louisa Clark and Joseph Clark, both fathers William Goodbourn and James Pettit Clark are farm labourers.

They were married by certificate in according to the rites and ceremonies of the Wesleyan Methodists. Being married by certificate means both parties have to be resident in the registration area for the district for 7 days, your names are then entered into the official notice book and you have to wait a further 21 days before you are issued a certificate of authority by the registrar, only then can you can marry.

1851 William was living and working at Crisp Farm the owner was Ann Hogben age 61 and a widow, William was employed as an agricultural labourer.
1861 William was working as an ag. labourer at Crispe Farm, Acol where he was also living. The farm was owned by Ann Hogben, a widow, and farmer, who employed three hands.

The 1871 census shows William and Francis living with their daughter Caroline aged 1, at 2, Summerfield Cottages, Station Road, Birchington, Kent, The home of her father, James Clark. William's occupation is shown as groundwork (lab).

The 1881 census shows William and Frances living at 49, Coutts Road, Mile End Old Town, parish of St Lukes, Tower Hamlets. Their daughter Caroline, born 1870, was born in Birchington Kent. William 1872 (son) was born in Whitechapel, Middlesex, and daughter Harriet born 1880, Mile End, Middlesex. (Father) William was shown as being a brewer's servant.

1891 census shows them living at 140 Old Church Road, Mile End Old Town, with Harriet, William (father) is a general labourer.
1901 census William and Francis are shown as living with son William and his wife Elizabeth, he is shown as being a "workman port". They are living at 37, Hawkins Street, Bow East London. I have left off the ages of Caroline and William at the time of the 1881 census as they do not compute with the age stated on the marriage certificate for William (son), this is not unusual.
1911 William and Frances are living 21, Emmott Street Stepney William is a night watchman aged 65.

William died on the 17/02/1926 aged 80, at 8, Single Street, Mile End Old Town, he died from 1) Bronchitis 20) Myocardial degeneration, informant was William Goodbourn son, of 48, Westbury Road Barking, Essex. his wife Francis died 17/11/1927, at 48 Westbury Road, Barking, Essex, aged 86 from myocardial degeneration (no PM) both William and Frances are buried in the Rippleside cemetery, plot i127 an unmarked grave, William was interred 22/02/1926 and Frances 24/11/1927 they have with them John Frederick a baby interred 22/02/1934 son of Frederick and Selina who died at thirteen days old. William

was brought from Single Street, to enable Frances, who had moved in with them to join him in the grave when she died.

JOHN GOODBOURN 1847 AND CAROLINE BROWN (son of William and Mary Ann nee Hawkins)

Witnesses to the marriage were Charles and Margaret Pymer Caroline was living at 13, Poyser Street Bethnal Green at the time of her marriage.

1891 Caroline and Arthur and baby Caroline are living in the same building as her parents William and Francis, although in different rooms and as a separate

family. Arthur is a general labourer. (141, Old Church Road, Mile End Old Town).

1901 They are living at 4, Marsh Street Poplar, with the rest of the children. Arthur is still a general labourer

WILLIAM AND ELIZABETH NEE UNWIN

According to the records William George Goodbourn born 1872, son of William and Frances nee Clark, was the first Goodbourn to be born outside the Birchington area. Up to his marriage in 1891 he was living with his parents and siblings.

1891 William now married to Elizabeth Unwin are living with her mother, also called Elizabeth and aged 61, at 14, ????well Road, Mile End Old Town, both mother and daughter are shown as being shirt machinists, William Goodbourn is a horse keeper (groom). In 1894 at the time of the baby William George's death they were living at 16, Bermuda Street Mile End.

1901 William George Goodbourn (father) ,and Elizabeth were living at 37, Hawkins Street, Mile End Old Town, with his parents, (William and Frances), there were five of the children living with them, Elizabeth Francis 9, Lucy Florence 6, George William , Florence May 2, and William Harry 4 months 2 weeks. All children with the exception of Elizabeth Florence and William George, were born in Stepney, Elizabeth Florence was born in Bow, William George who died aged 9 months, was born in Mile End, William (father) is stated as being a wine cellar man.

1911 They were living 48, Westbury Road Barking William is still a wine cellar man, they have the following children with them Elizabeth Frances 19 a rubber lapping, Lucy 16 a waterproof collar maker, George William 14 a farmhand, Florence May 12, William Harry 10, Maud Lillian 8, Albert Stanley 6, Frederick John 4 and Elsie Adelaide 2.

At the time of his marriage he was living at 20, Salisbury Street, London, and he is stated as being a car man. By 1903 they had moved to Barking first to 63, St. Margaret's Road, when the electoral list was compiled in 1912, the family were still in St Margaret's Road, but it reads as follows – 63, St Margaret's Road successive to 48, Westbury Road, this means they would have been on the point of moving, they stayed in Westbury Road until they died.

The remainder of the children were born in Barking, they were Maud, Hilda, and Doris, (who died aged 1) Elsie, Albert, Thomas and Frederick, all of them with the exception of Doris and Hilda were born in St. Margaret's Road, Doris and Hilda being born in Westbury Road. William (father) and sons Thomas and Bert used to work in a chemical company in Gascoigne Road, Barking, may have been William Warne & Company.

Elizabeth died on the 23/01/1938 aged 65, from pneumonia, in East-Ham Memorial Hospital, death was registered by Lucy F. Mansfield, daughter, of 115, Perth Road Barking, Essex, William George (father) died on the 14/01/1951 aged 79, at 478, Ripple Road Barking Essex, present at death, his son, G.W. Goodbourn, he died from senility, Elizabeth, William and baby Doris are buried together in the Rippleside cemetery in plot E982, an unmarked grave.
