This drawing, made in 1788, shows it at its worst, for by that date it was let to three farmers and was in very bad repair.

In Anna's day, the garden in front of the house would have had lawns, which were scythed at intervals.

John Powell Powell demolished the old house in 1809 and rebuilt the Quex House we now know.
