- **LESLIE ROAD** Sir Charles Robert Leslie writer & painter d. 1859
- **LYELL ROAD** Sir Charles Lyell d. 1875 Lawyer, Geologist and influential friend of Darwin
- NASMYTH ROAD Alexander Nasmyth 1758-1840 Artist
- **ROSSETTI ROAD** Dante Gabriel Rossetti d. 1882 in Birchington Poet and Painter
- **SHAKESPEARE ROAD** William Shakespeare d, 1616 playwright and poet
- **SPENSER ROAD** Sir Edmund Spenser d. 1599 poet (Faerie Queene)
- **GAINSBOROUGH ROAD** Thomas Gainsborough d. 1788 portrait and landscape artist
- **CONSTABLE ROAD** John Constable d. 1837 landscape artist
- **WILKIE ROAD** Sir David Wilkie d. 1841 artist knew John Seddon
