

'Twentieth Century' 102 Minnis Road.

This house was built for an estate agent called Kathleen Hawkes. Her husband was a builder and he almost certainly built it for her. It was erected by 1935 and is listed in the 1936 Kelly's Directory. He had an office in Station Road in the centre of the village, while his wife had an office in the front right hand corner of their new house. Its entrance was under a porch cover, just visible beneath the 'Y' of 'Bay'.

The building had become rather sad looking by the end of the twentieth century, but its new owners have done wonders with it. They have given it some delightful new stained-glass windows and some new railings along the top of the walling round the front garden, very much in keeping with its period.

Now called The White House (2016), it is up for sale at offers of around £535,000.
