ALYS CRISPE: She was the 1st wife of John Crispe the Younger and has her daughter beside her. Alys died on 18th February 1518. Whether her daughter had died by then is not known. Her inclusion on the brass does not necessarily signify this, as the John Quek brass makes clear. Alys was the mother of Henry Crispe, whose figure lies on the nearby altar tomb. The remains of her inscription reads:-

“ the wife of John
..... Alys decessyd the X
..... MVcXVIII on whos

Her brass is on the west end of the N. wall of Quex Chapel.
