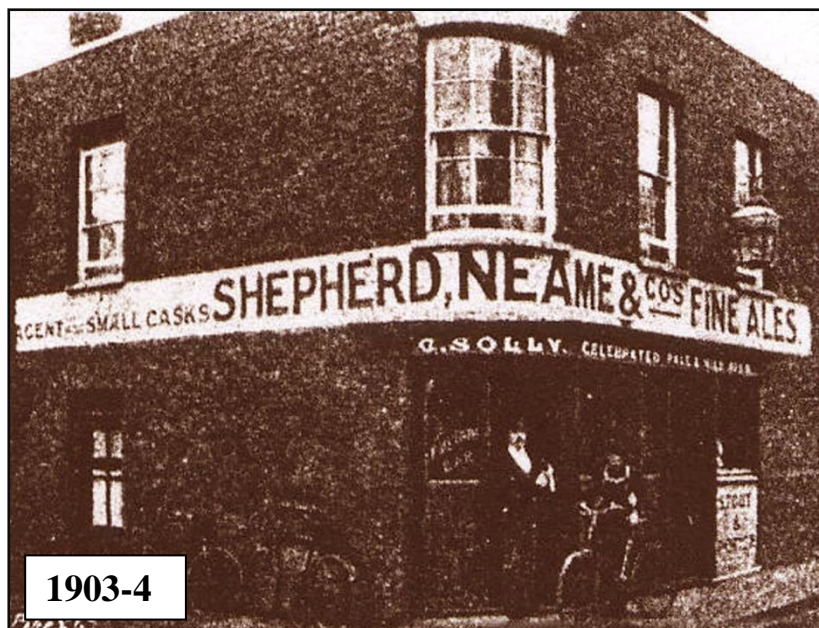
Vol 7 p. 66 It appears from Poor Book that travellers with passes – soldiers and widows stayed for the night at the Acorn Inn.

2015 – The Acorn was closed as an inn, as the couple were unable to sell it as a going concern, but as they couldn't sell they decided to remain there as a private house, which was what it was in 1840.
