"for all that plot, piece or parcel of land situate in Park Lane Birchington abutting north-east and south-east on the property of the vendor, Percy Horace Powell-Cotton, north-west on land also belonging to the vendor and intended by him to become the site for a proposed new road, and south-west abutting Park Lane."

The frontage is 25 feet ('or thereabouts') and the depth is 75 feet, after allowing for the widening of the road (Park Lane) into a 40-foot public road.
