Road improvements on the north side of the railway bridge in Minnis Road, Birchington, are to be carried out in the near future.

Margate Town Council was told by Alderman G.B Farrar, J.P. on Tuesday that the work would be carried out long before the season started.

The Council decided to take no action on a request from Birchington Chamber of Commerce that "Danger, drive slowly" signs should be erected on either side of the bridge.

Both Councillor J.G.Read and Councillor R.C.Presland suggested that the road had become even more dangerous because of the number of American cars now in the area. "Birchington is becoming a suburb of the U.S.A." commented Councillor Read
