POSTCARD 500 COMPETITION 2025: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Only postcards supplied by the Trust shall be used.
2. All the details required on the postcard shall be completed.
3. Entries must be received no later than Sunday 31 August 2025. Late entries won't be considered.
4. Any artistic medium can be used (e.g., crayon, paint, pencil).
5. The artwork must be the designer's own work and not computer-generated. Direct copying of existing postcards, whether contemporary or historic, is not allowed; however, designers can take inspiration from some of the Trust's collection of existing postcards which will be exhibited at the Baptist Church Centre, Crescent Road on 5th and 6th July.
6. Competition judges will consider the most creative and imaginative designs that best show Birchington as a seaside village today. Their decision will be final.
7. Prizes will be awarded for the design which, in the opinion of the judges, is best in each age group. Age groups are 4-6, 7-10, 11-13, 14-17, 18+. Certificates will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each age group. The award of a prize or certificate is at the discretion of the judges.
8. By entering the competition, the designer agrees that Birchington Heritage Trust will have the sole right to publish and sell copies of any postcard at any time and at their discretion. Up to 10 copies of those which it intends to sell shall be given to the original designer without charge. Copies may be exhibited in the Museum and at any future events.
9. Any dispute arising from this competition shall be considered by the Trustees, whose decision shall be final.
